

BASE RULES for U14-U15-U16 Leagues and Championship in Football & Hurling

Normal GAA Playing Rules Apply

15 a side games

Exceptions to 15 a side to be competition specified

Play Off - i.e. Semi-finals & Quarter finals to be competition specified

Any team giving a Walk Over cannot qualify -

Only in exceptional circumstances can a club appeal to Bord CCC re walkover - there will be no appeal in relation to last round walkovers

Any team giving Two Walk Overs will be disqualified from competition and subsequent games

Referee's decision on score is deemed correct and final

All Finals play 15 a side

Clash of Jerseys Rule will apply

All games must be up to date before last round are played

U16 Football League Competition Rules 2015

Div 1 & 2

15 a side, Normal Playing Rules Apply

The Top 4 Teams will qualify for Semi Finals

The Group Winners will play at home to the fourth placed team

The Second Placed Team will play at home the third placed team

If home venue unplayable match must be transferred to oppositions ground.

Sufficient notice must be given in the event of match transfer

If a team gives TWO walkovers they will be disqualified from the competition.

If teams finish level on points the following will determine group Placings

Rule 6.22 will apply

All match results must be sent to the Division Co-ordinator

In the event of any dispute re score difference the referee's score is deemed correct and final.

Div 3 & 5

Div 3 and 5 is a 15 a side competition

Less than 15 a side shall be by agreement not to be withheld

Minimum number is 13 a side

Teams seeking to play less than 15 a side shall not be allowed substitutions in that game

Div 4

Div 4 is 15 side competition

Less than 15 a side shall be by agreement not to be withheld

Minimum number is 12 a side

Teams seeking to play less than 15 a side shall not be allowed substitutions in that game

Normal rules shall apply to the opposing team in that game

Referees to be informed before start of game

The Top 4 Teams will qualify for Semi Finals

The Group Winners will play at home to the fourth placed team

The Second Placed Team will play at home the third placed team

If home venue unplayable match must be transferred to oppositions ground.

Sufficient notice must be given in the event of match transfer
